



# Basic Plain Language Principles

- Know your target audience
- Use simple and direct words, short sentences, and short paragraphs
- Design so the reader can easily navigate to important information
  - ✓ Use a readable font
  - ✓ Use bullet points and headings
  - ✓ Use font changes (color, size, *style*) strategically















# 2022 ACS self-response contact strategy


### **Self-Response Return Rates by Mailing**




