## Journal of Survey Statistics and Methodology (JSSAM) 2023 Annual Report

## **Executive Summary:**

- JSSAM's impact factor increased in 2022, coming from 1.957 to 2.446, with rankings of 23/53 in Social Sciences, Mathematical Methods and 29/125 in Statistics and Probability (improving from the corresponding 2020 rankings of 29/52 and 46/125).
- JSSAM received 164 new submissions in 2022, similar to 2021 (Table 1). An additional 90 revisions were in progress, so the Editors managed about 250 manuscript submissions during 2022.
- In 2022, more new submissions came in on the survey methodology side of the journal about 59% vs. 41% on the survey statistics side. Desk rejection rates were about 30% on both sides of the journal, and about slightly more than half of the manuscripts sent out for review were rejected after first review. Rejection rates have been increasing over time, possibly due to the introduction of double-blind review in 2021. Acceptance rates have been decreasing over time as the number of submissions have also increased.
- The acceptance rate for manuscripts submitted in 2021 was 27%, similar across the two sections. For manuscripts submitted in 2022, 14% have been accepted as of May 2023, with 18 manuscripts still active in the peer review process.
- The overall time-to-decision held steady at about 48 days (about 7 weeks), including an average time for a desk rejection of about one week (Table 2). On average, authors of new submissions are receiving decision letters within two months.
- The number of reviewers invited and who declined the invitation to review increased again in 2022 (Table 3). This increase was larger on the Survey Methodology side of the journal, but both sides saw increases, requiring invitations to over 4 reviewers (4.8 reviewers invited on the survey methodology side; 3.8 on the statistics side) to receive an average of 2 completed reviews per manuscript.
- In 2022, JSSAM published 60 papers from 182 unique authors, representing 21 countries.
- Submissions are up in 2023. We have had 87 new submissions as of the writing of this report, an increase of 30 submissions over the same time in 2022.
- JSSAM published its first Editor's Choice article in April 2023: "Preferred Reporting Items for Complex Sample Survey Analysis (PRICSSA)" by Andrew B. Seidenberg, Richard P. Moser, Brady T. West. <a href="https://doi.org/10.1093/jssam/smac040">https://doi.org/10.1093/jssam/smac040</a> This important checklist of items for reporting in analyses of complex sample survey data includes, but expands beyond, the AAPOR disclosure items. We will be requiring authors reporting on analyses of complex survey data to use the PRICSSA checklist and are in the process of incorporating this into the instructions to authors.
- After two years of statistically-focused special issues (Privacy and Confidentiality; Data integration), the 2024 Special Issue will be on Innovations in Mixed Mode Surveys. The guest editors (Stephanie Coffey, Olga Maslovskaya, and Cameron McPhee) are in the process of reviewing manuscripts.

- We anticipate being able to largely clear the lingering JSSAM backlog of articles by the end of the year.
- We continue to attempt to group accepted manuscripts into issues that are thematic, even when not in a special issue.
- Two new Statistics side and one new Survey Methodology Associate Editors have been onboarded: Alina Matei, Maria Giovanna Ranalli, and Bella Struminskaya. Jon Hohne also recently (May 1, 2023) agreed to join the Survey Methodology Associate Editor team.
